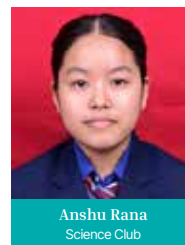

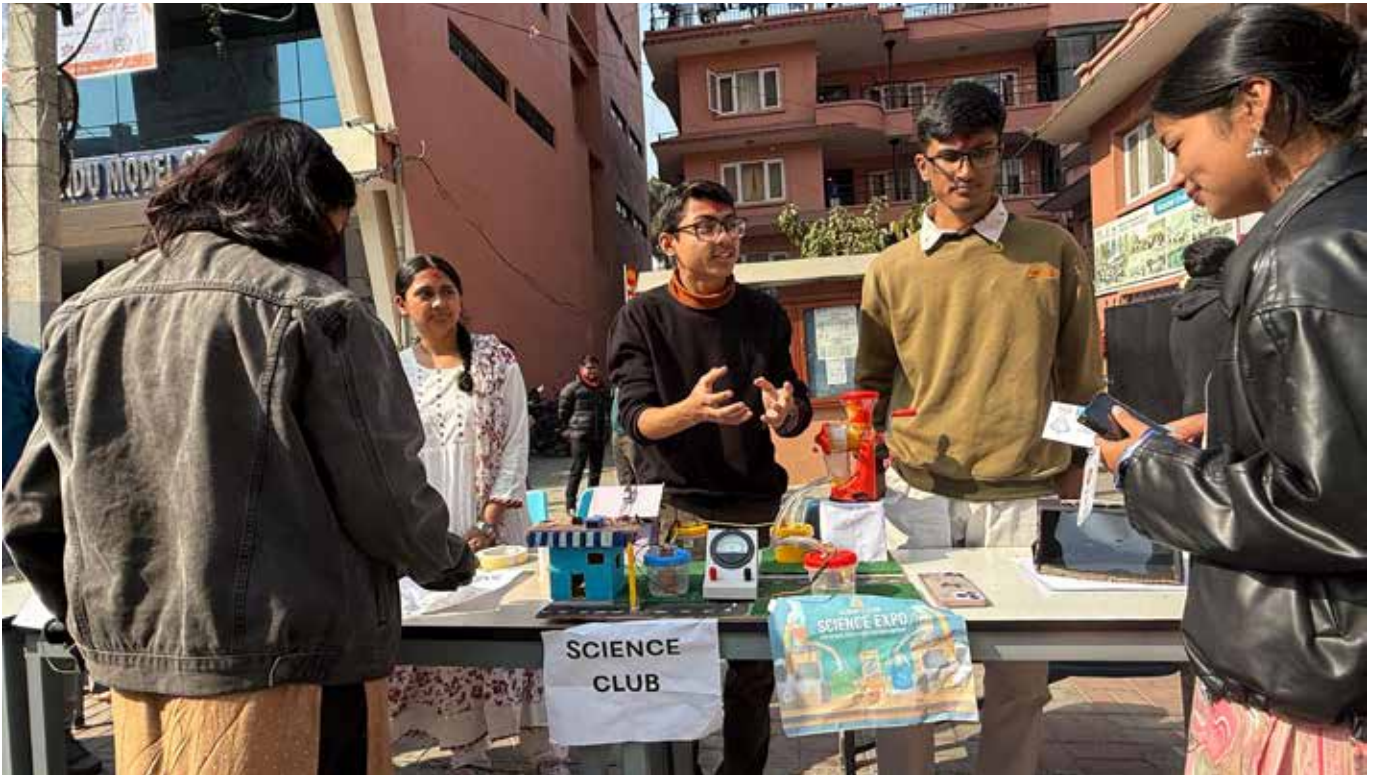




## Singing and Dancing
