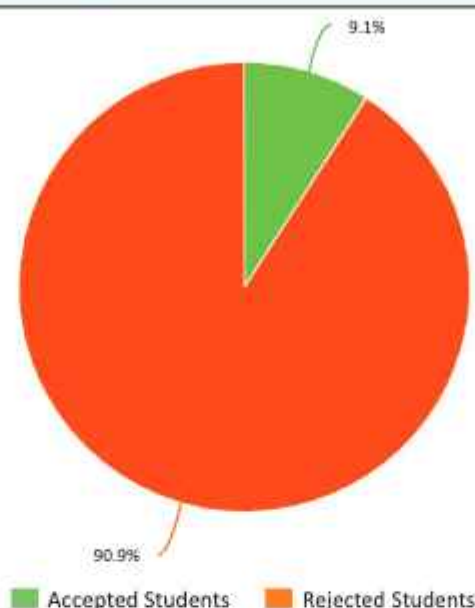

Accreditation & Grading Requirement

Kathmandu Model Secondary School has been accredited and certified by National Examinations Board (NEB). KMSS is approved to offer courses in Science, Management, Humanities, and Law. NEB requires a student to take courses adding a minimum of 26.57 credits per year. However, KMSS requires 39.375 credits per year for a student to qualify for board examination.

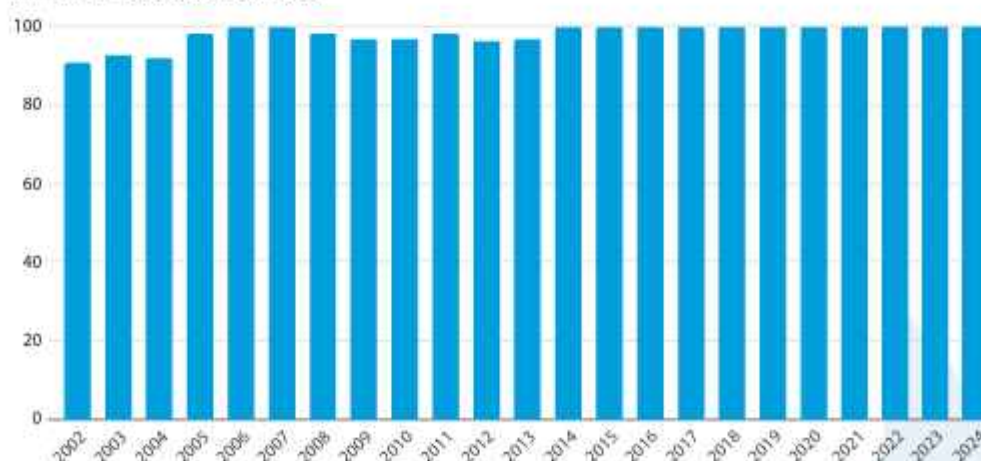

HOSTELS
